Please deliver unexpired food items to the Narthex (main lobby at back of church) before Mass on April 24-25 in either the attached bag or in plastic grocery store bags. The Knights of Columbus will deliver the donations to the Food Pantry.

Items Needed to restock the Catholic Charities Loudoun Food Pantry in Sterling

- Canned meals (Chili; Beef Stew; Raviolli, etc.)
- Canned Veggies (green beans NOT needed)
- Snacks (individually wrapped preferred)
- Boxed Pasta; Spaghetti
- Canned Meats (Chicken, tuna, etc.)
- Mac & Cheese
- Rice (smaller 1-2 lb bags
- Tomato products -Canned or Plastic jars (Sauce, Dices, etc)
- Canned Fruit
- Cereal
- Oatmeal (1 box or canister)
- Jelly (peanut butter NOT needed)
- Oil, Flour, Sugar
- Reusable grocery bags (NO Plastics new or gently used)

<u>GiftCards/Checks</u>: The Loudoun Food Pantry accepts checks or gift cards to purchase needed items. <u>Checks</u>: make payable to "Catholic Charities" and put "Loudoun Regional Office" (or "LRO") in the memo portion. <u>Gift Cards</u>: mark envelop with "Catholic Charities" (or "CCDA").

<u>Place</u> the checks or gift cards in the lock box labeled "Divine Mercy Outreach." They are mounted on the wall by each Church entrance. (Note: the box in the Narthex is located by the elevator). The DMO Director will arrange to deliver the donations to the Pantry.
